SUBJECT: Criteria for registration in the Register of Mediators of the Cyprus Arbitration & Mediation Centre (C. A. M. C)

1. Any person may be registered in the Register of Mediators, provided that he satisfies the following criteria:

1.1. is registered in the Register of Practicing Advocates and holds an annual license to practice as an advocate in accordance with the Advocates' Law and has completed a mediation training course with a duration of at least forty (40) hours.

1.2. has not been convicted of a serious criminal offence or of an offence involving a lack of honesty or moral obscenity; and

1.3. there are no convictions against him by the Disciplinary Board of the Cyprus Bar Association within the last five years for disciplinary offences involving dishonesty and/or that led to the deprivation of the license of the applicant to practice as an advocate.

2. A person who: -

2.1. has been registered in the Register of Mediators pursuant to subparagraph 1.1. of paragraph 1, must continue his mediation training by completing at least twenty-four (24) hours of training every three years, the first three years starting from the lapse of three (3) years from the date of his/her registration in the Register of Mediators, and submit a relevant certificate to the Centre.

3. A person may be registered in the Register of Mediators following an invitation by the Council or an application to the Board which shall be examined by the Board on the basis of the criteria set out in paragraph (1) above. The Board of Directors may exceptionally include in the Register of Mediators persons who are not members of the Cyprus Bar Association, who are members of the law society or bar association of another country, and who have the necessary knowledge and experience in mediation or generally in dispute resolution and are of recognized standing.
