

Chrysthia is an Assistant Professor of Commercial Law at the Open University of Cyprus. She is a member of the Cyprus Bar Association, an insolvency practitioner and a member of STEP (Society of Trustees and Estate Practitioners). In 2022 Chrysthia was appointed examiner of Company law by the Cyprus Bar Council. She is an Honorary Fellow of the Association of Fellows & Legal Scholars of the Centre of International Legal Studies. Chrysthia holds an LLB from King's College, University of London, an LLM in Anglo-American Law with Commendation from City University and a PhD with scholarship, from University of London, Birkbeck College. From 2004 to 2018 she was a senior partner at Law Chambers Nicos Papacleovoulou LLC and consultant at Spyros Vassiliou & Associates LLC. Since joining academia, Chrysthia practices law in cases with academic interest. Chrysthia has extensive experience and expertise in corporate & commercial law, civil and cross-border commercial litigation, private international law, conflicts of laws, international commercial arbitration and investment arbitration (part of the legal team in the ICSID Adamakopoulos case v. Cyprus). She provided evidence as expert witness on Cyprus law before the High Court of Justice and in arbitration cases. Her research interests focus on company law, crossborder commercial judicial disputes, corporate and tax planning, trust law and arbitration. She has taught numerous modules at private and state universities in Cyprus and Birkbeck including European Company Law, International Tax law, International Economic Law, Commercial Law, Arbitration, and presented at local and international conferences. Chrysthia is the author of several book chapters and articles in international legal journals on commercial, tax, arbitration and company law matters.
